### Ride the Shuttle

Avoid traffic lines at entrance and searching for a place to park within the National Park by taking a shuttle from Tusayan locations (below). Shuttle will take you to the main visitor center within the Park and from there you can take a free shuttle to the various view points located along the South Rim.

Shuttle is FREE with purchase of National Park Pass.
